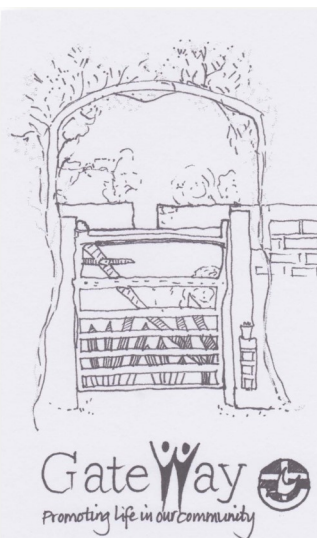

With the ringing of his golden bell Santa departed leaving a flurry of excited and happy children, both young and old..... See you next year Santa!!

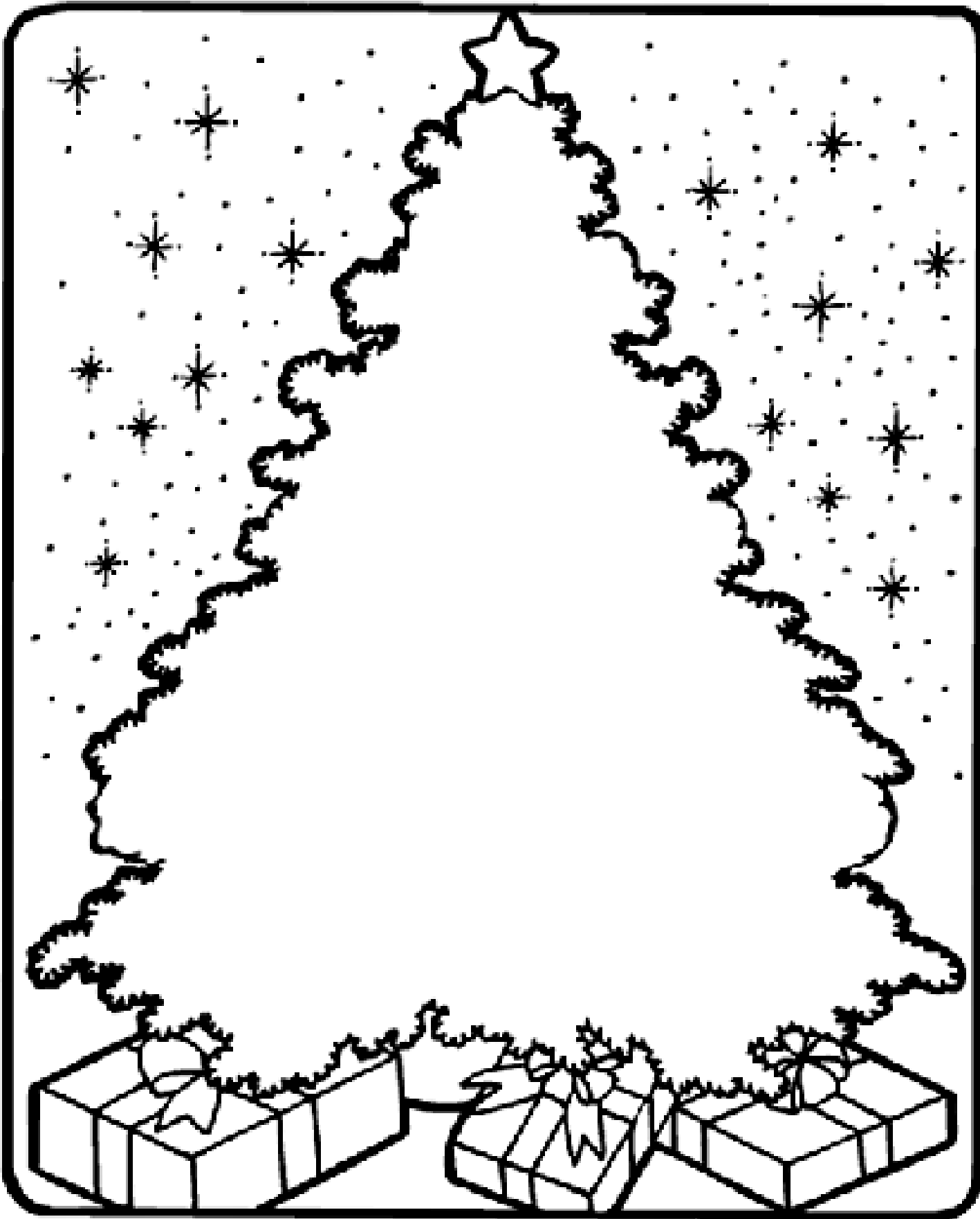

### Cricket - Newdegate V Karlgarin 8/12/2018

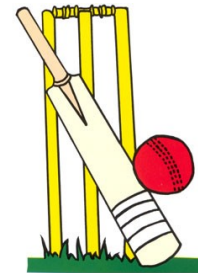
Due to harvest commitments and racing against the weather to get crops off this contest was going to be a very even one with both teams missing key players.

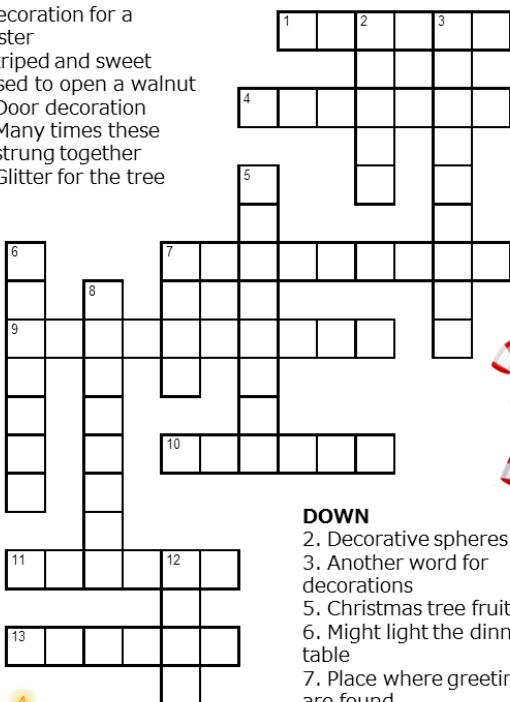

## Stay safe during summer fun

It's that time of year when thoughts turn to holiday and festive fun but popular activities and items can pose risks.

It's important for parents and carers to be aware of potential hazards for young children and all of us need to put safety first while still having fun.

Water awareness is an obvious issue that springs to mind in summer but consumers also need to be aware of product safety when buying gifts.

Consumer protection regulators throughout the country have launched a Safe Summer campaign which will run from 10 to 21 December 2018 to highlight these possible dangers.

It is important we all ensure the gifts we choose are age appropriate and safe. For example, button batteries in items such as toys and remote controls can be a risk if not properly secured and some toys may pose a choking hazard for younger children.

Always read warning labels and follow all safety instructions. This also applies to ever-popular trampolines, with hundreds of Australian children taken to hospital each year for injuries such as cuts, sprains and fractures.

While parents and carers may initially focus on the tricky job of putting the trampolines together for the big reveal on Christmas Day, it is also vital to make sure you supervise trampoline use and only allow one child to use it at a time.

Supervising children when they are in and near water is vital. Young children are put at risk when portable pools aren't emptied between uses or larger above and below ground pools aren't appropriately fenced. Kids can die or be left with a permanent brain injury from drowning even in a small portable pool that contains very little water. So never leave babies or children unsupervised in any water and remember that baby bath aids or pool toys are not safety devices.

It's also important to check for toppling furniture hazards when visiting relatives or staying in holiday accommodation, plus blind and curtain cords can pose a strangulation hazard for children.

Adults also need to stop and think about their own safety too – the end of year clean-up can lead to injuries if ladders aren't properly secured.

So whether inside or outside, shopping or making handcrafted gifts, it is important to keep safety issues in mind.

## Keep Safe over Summer

- \* **Practise Sun Safety**—use sunscreen, sun-protective clothing (a hat, long sleeved shirts) and sunglasses
- \* **Prevent Dehydration**—drink water throughout the day especially when exercising or out in the heat; keep hydrated in airconditioned vehicles too!

# Bushfire Season

## Fire Chat and Bushfire Preparation Toolkit

You can't outrun it, or outlast it. So take five minutes to outsmart it.

It only takes five minutes to have a Fire Chat with your family about what you will do when a bushfire threatens to determine:

- When will you know to leave?
- Where will you go?
- Which way will you go?

In a bushfire, the single biggest killer is indecision. Making a decision early will help you to implement the plan when you are threatened by fire and under stress.

Once you have had your Fire Chat you can use the Bushfire Preparation Toolkit to either prepare and plan to be safe by leaving, or stay and defend your property.

It is a simple step-by-step plan to assist you to prepare yourself and your property in the event of a bushfire.

## Responding to Bushfires

Be aware of your surroundings and stay up to date with the conditions in your area, particularly if it's a hot and windy day.

If you see smoke or flames act immediately to survive. Don't wait for a text message, a knock at the door or for emergency services to turn up at your home.

During an incident electricity may be cut and communications may be down; you may not be able to make or receive phone calls through your mobile or landline or have access to the internet.

You need to have an emergency kit ready to go in case you are evacuated or cut off during a bushfire.

The kit should contain a battery powered portable radio, spare batteries, torch, first aid kit, woollen blanket, water and non-perishable food.

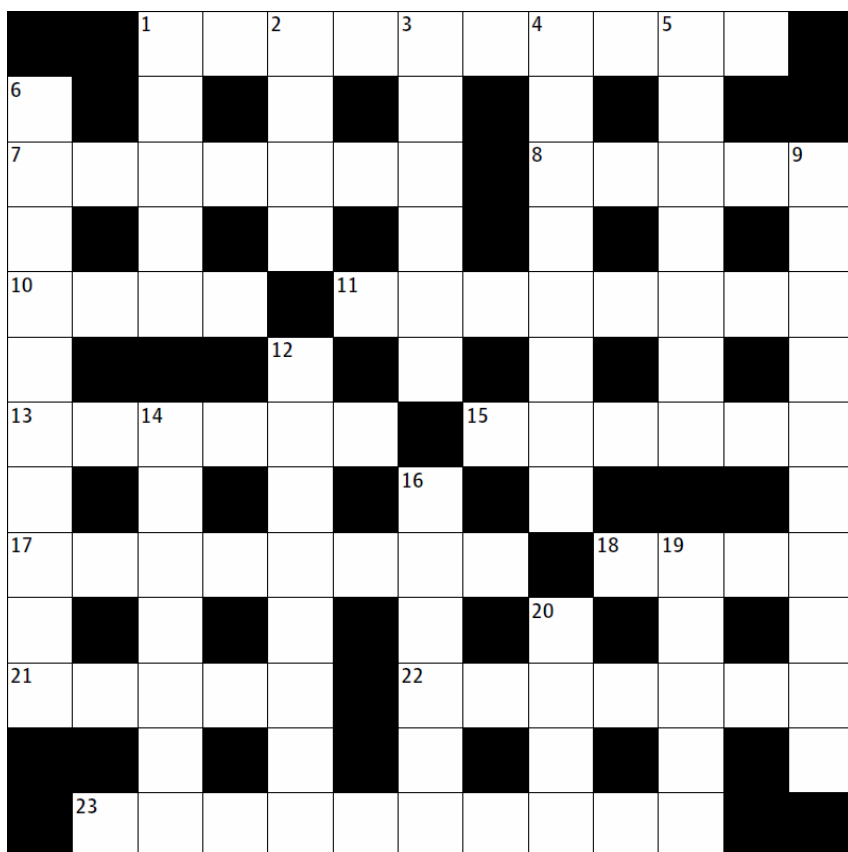

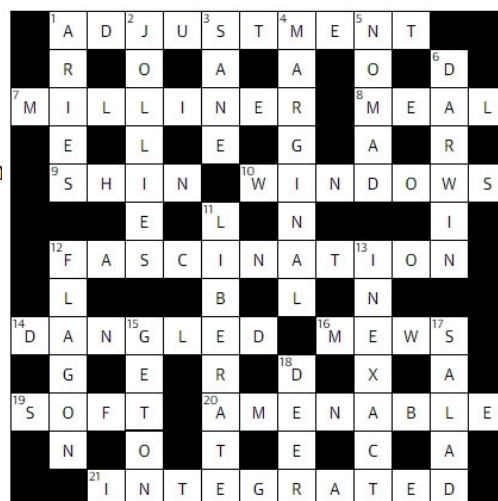

# Recipe Page

## Mince pies

### Ingredients

- 360g mixed dried fruit
- 200g brown sugar
- 50g almonds, finely chopped
- 1 apple, coarsely grated
- 40g butter, melted
- 2 tablespoons brandy
- 3 teaspoons finely grated lemon rind
- 1 Tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon mixed spice
- Pinch of ground nutmeg
- 1 egg, lightly whisked
- White sugar, to dust
- Short crust pastry



### Method

1. Finely chop half of the mixed fruit. Place in a large bowl. Add the brown sugar, almonds, lemon rind, apple, butter, brandy, lemon juice, cinnamon, mixed spice, nutmeg and the remaining fruit. Stir until well combined. Cover with plastic wrap and set aside overnight, stirring occasionally to macerate.
2. Roll out pastry onto a lightly floured surface until 5mm thick. Use an 8.5cm-diameter round pastry cutter to cut 20 discs from the pastry. Use a 5cm diameter star-shaped pastry cutter to cut 20 stars from the remaining pastry.
3. Line a 20 hole muffin pan with the discs and divide mincemeat amongst them. Top with the pastry stars. Brush the stars lightly with egg and sprinkle with white sugar. Bake for 20-25 minutes or until light golden. Set aside in the pan for 5 minutes to cool before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.
