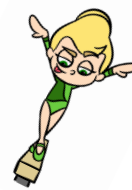

My word, it has been a busy fortnight and the following one does not appear to be slowing down.

It all started with a visit from the **Coffin Cheaters Outlaw Motorcycle Gang** earlier the previous week. No matter what your personal opinion of these groups may be, Police policy is to ensure that trouble doesn't follow wherever they go. As a police officer I fully agree with this policy, especially when they travel and interact en mass – there's a good reason why they're called outlaw motorcycle gangs.

In this instance, a group of approximately 35 members of the gang descended on Newdegate and while there weren't any problems initially, their behaviour deteriorated later that evening resulting in Police being called to sort out several issues. The gang members moved on the following day to complete a week-long tour of the south-west but did so in the company of Police.

Operation Bluesun - which is the firearms check for those over the age of 60 - continues to be undertaken. Just when I think we are done, some of the outstations send me another 20 to check. We will also be visiting the folks at Pingrup (not our district) to assist Police from Katanning with these checks.

However, I must say that as a result of these checks I have enjoyed meeting many people from around the district and in town when I have called to visit. I've never drunk so much tea or eaten so

much cake. The hospitality is wonderful.

I completed my **roadside drug twin wipe course** last week and should soon be receiving my first batch of twin wipes for use within our sub-district. Police will now be able to roadside test drivers for cannabis and methamphetamine (and derivatives) use. The law is pretty clear on drug driving and does not distinguish the different levels of impairment like drink driving (eg, excess 0.02 0.05, 0.08 and DUI) Therefore you only have to have traces of a drug in your system and it's all downhill from there.

Also just a quick reminder about **drink driving**: the allowable level for any person operating a heavy vehicle, a bus, taxi, Uber, is an L, E or P plater is ZERO.

Funny story for you - I recently assisted Kondinin Police with their Kondinin Kruisers event last week. At noon we had set up an RBT station just outside town where we stopped a woman from the Eastern States in a hire car. Gave her an RBT and her result was off the chart. She was flabbergasted and explained she did have a few drinks but stopped at midnight the night before. As a result she was taken for an evidentiary breath test at the station which resulted in a totally zero reading from the "big" machine (that's the one that counts). After much confusion it was discovered that she was a compulsive user of a skin moisturiser that was basically made up of pure wood alcohol mixed with smellies. It was a pump pack spray and it completely interfered with

the roadside test making it read positive. It was her first time in a police car and going through the back entrance of the police station (usually never a good thing) but she was most relieved that her trip back to her car was a bit better than her trip to the station. She now has several photos of the experience including the printout of the test to show her mates back East.

Fuel stealing from a business premises in Newdegate - A business premises in Newdegate was entered on Thursday 4 April around 10pm until 10.45pm. Approximately 2,000 litres of diesel fuel was stolen from a trailer tank. If anybody saw something suspicious that night around that time can you please call Lake Grace Police. CCTV vision was obtained and we're looking for a vehicle that is capable of making off with that amount of fuel.

Events coming up:

I recently received a copy of the **football fixtures** for 2019 and have tried to where I can to have staff rostered on to make an appearance at the games and mingle. We encourage everyone in attendance to have a good time and look after each other if a few drinks are to be had.

Easter/ANZAC Day public holidays - Police from every station will be rostered on conducting visible traffic patrols everywhere at all times. Please take your time when travelling, have plenty of stops or swap drivers. We have only had one fatal crash (last week) in the entire Great Southern District so far for the April period. The superintendent wants to keep it this way. So do I - one death is too many. And I hate doing death notifications. So keep a lid on the following:

- **Wear your belt** - I have seen people use their face to remove the front windscreen while the cold beers in the esky were strapped in the back seat.
- **Don't drive if you've had a few** or even better bring your swag just in case.

- **Don't drive if you're tired** - I've heard sleeping is better than dying.
- **Slow down** - you will still get there and possibly be richer for the experience.
- **Stop at stop signs and traffic lights** - slowing down is not stopping, pretend you're going for your driver's licence test again.
- **Mobile phone** - stick it in the boot where you can't be tempted to check how many likes you received for posting pictures of the last selfie you took.

Blazing Swan - I have never heard of this event before, I obviously move in different circles. It's being held in Kulin over the Easter long weekend. Essentially it appears that the folk from Fremantle descend upon Kulin for the week to participate in a week's worth of free love, frivolity, music, tattoos, art, tofu and sprouts (I have heard clothes are optional). It's being held on private property and has numerous themed camp categories such as "Bad Advice", "Steampunk Pancakes", "Camp S.H.I.T.G.I.F.T", "Aiding and A-Betting", "Fluff Box" and "Greasy Pirates" to name a few. There is also a temple being provided for the virgins amongst us. The weeklong event culminates in the burning of a large swan effigy at the end - not sure why but it does. Then everybody departs as if they have never been there, assuming they can remember where they parked their cars.

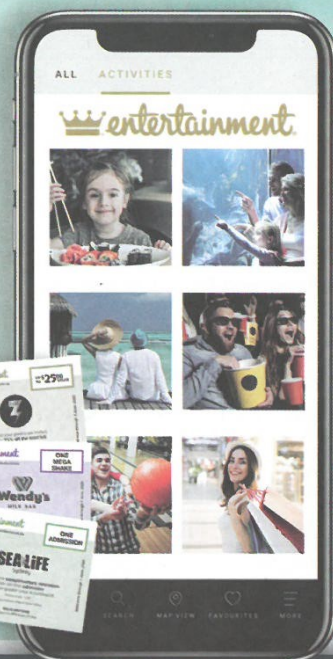



Avoid lemons on car auction websites

Buying a vehicle via online auction has left a WA consumer with a sour taste in her mouth after the car turned out to be a lemon.

The woman, who told her story on TV recently, bid \$6,000 because the SUV had only done 135,000km and seemed like a bargain.

But when she drove it away after purchase, it broke down almost immediately and a quote to repair it was \$6,000 for a new transmission.

In 2018 Consumer Protection received 20 complaints about cars bought at auction.

Auction websites selling cars are generally agents for private owners. There's no statutory warranty under the Motor Vehicle Dealer's Act and consumer guarantees under the Australian Consumer Law, such as acceptable quality and fit for purpose, don't apply either. This is because it is a private seller selling the vehicle.

Terms and conditions on auction sites usually stipulate that the vehicle is "sold as seen". In the

case of the woman with the \$6,000 lemon, the T&Cs went so far as to say their description was a guide based on a walk around inspection and start-up only AND recommended a full inspection to identify any unsighted damage or issues. Consumer Protection recommends taking a mechanic to inspect and we say do NOT buy sight unseen. Once you take the car away, if there's a mechanical failure you wear the cost of repair.

Although there is no legal requirement for the auction seller to disclose the condition of a vehicle, they cannot make false or misleading representations. For example it's not OK to say "top condition, no mechanical faults" as part of the sales blurb – in those circumstances if there was a fault, you could have some comeback.

Before you buy a car, research make and model reviews and check the Personal Properties Security Register (www.ppsr.gov.au) to ensure no money is owing on the vehicle. Head to www.consumerprotection.wa.gov.au for more tips.

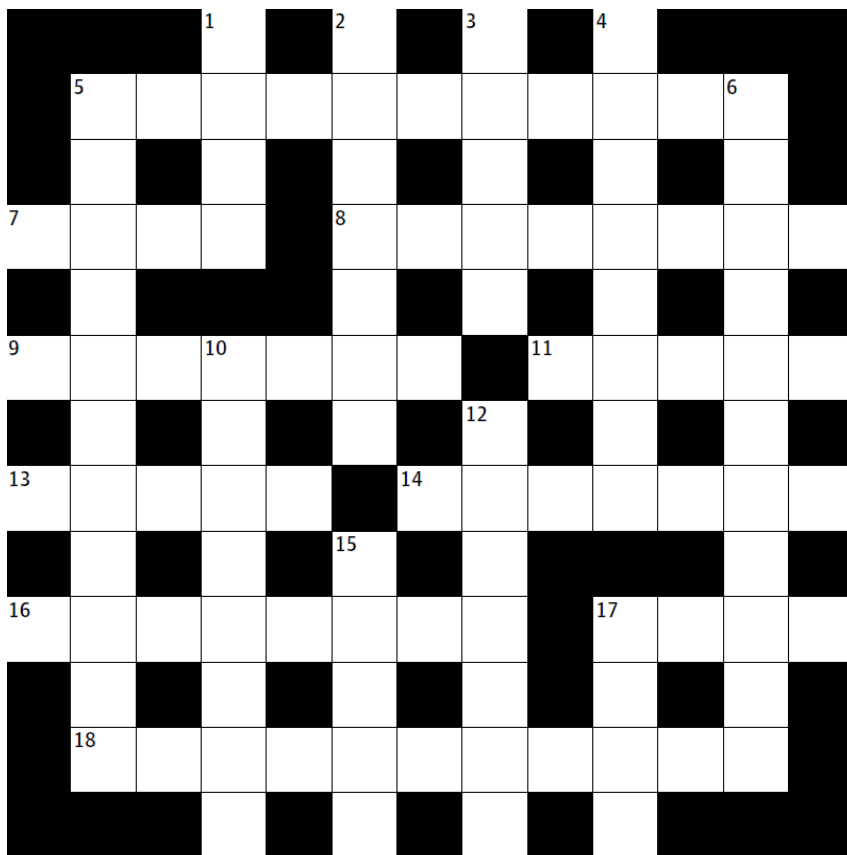

Recipe Page

Blueberry, pecan and banana breakfast slice

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup whole meal self raising flour
- 1/2 cup white self raising flour
- 1/4 cup shredded or desiccated coconut
- 2 tbs maple syrup
- 1tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp bicarbonate of soda
- 1 cup mashed banana
- 1/2 cup plain yoghurt
- 1 egg
- 150g blueberries (fresh or frozen)
- 1/4 cup pecans
- oil



Method

1. Preheat oven to 180 degrees. Lightly grease a shallow 23cm square cake tin with oil and line base and sides with baking paper extending 5cm over sides.
2. Sift flours, coconut, cinnamon and bicarbonate of soda into a large bowl. Stir in combined banana, yoghurt, maple syrup and egg until just combined. Stir in blueberries. Spread mixture into prepared tin and smooth surface. Sprinkle with pecans.
3. Bake for 20 minutes or until skewer inserted into centre comes out clean. Stand slice in tin for 5 minutes before turning onto wire rack to cool. Cut into squares.
