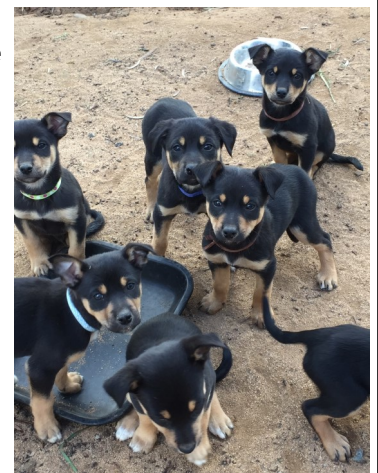

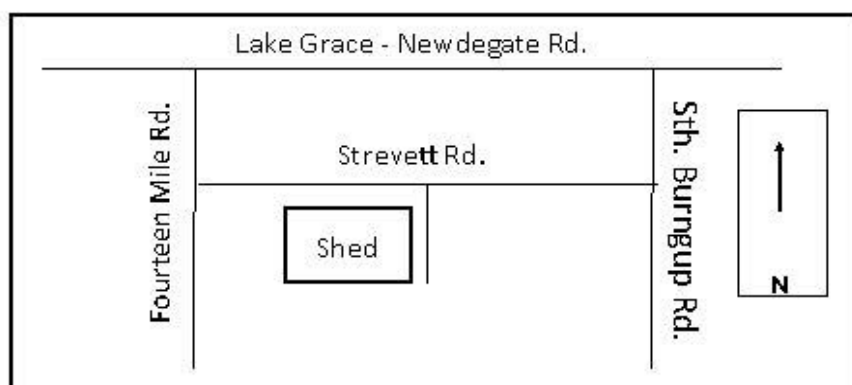

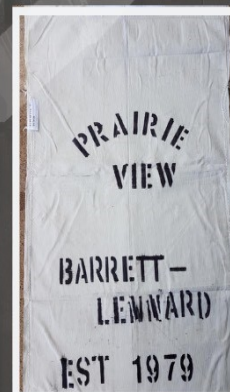

Fake Facebook friends lead victims to loose thousands in scams

Thousands of dollars are being lost by WA victims who are led into falling for grant or lottery prize scams by Facebook friends who have had their profiles cloned.

The victims get contacted by the cloned friend's profile via Messenger asking if they had received their money, as their name is on a list of recipients who have won money either from a grant scheme or a lottery. The victims are usually directed to a fake Facebook page or website that confirms their name on a list of winners.

The victims are then lured into a claims process that requires them to provide personal and financial information as well as pay upfront fees before receiving the money. A number of excuses are used to explain a delay in the payment being made, with more money being demanded in fees.

The victims are convinced the offer is genuine as their 'friend' on Facebook told them that they had received the money.

In the general category of 'unexpected money/winnings', 37 scam victims in WA have lost a total of almost \$600,000 so far this year.

Commissioner for Consumer Protection David Hillyard said a simple phone call to their friend could have prevented the losses.

"People have to be aware that the cloning of profiles is occurring so they need to be wary when they receive a message via social media regarding any financial windfall," Mr Hillyard said.

"Question why you would be getting money from a grant that you didn't apply for or from a lottery you didn't enter, so do some checking before you send any money.

"Rather than relying on communicating via social media, all it takes is a phone call to the friend in question to determine if the offer is genuine or not. An online search of the name of the company or organisation supposedly making the

offer may also uncover that it's a scam.

"This scam would have been preceded by the acceptance of a friend request from someone who is already your friend on Facebook, so that should get alarm bells ringing.

"We recommend that Facebook users put their security setting to the highest possible so there is less likelihood that scammers can get access to their details, friends' list and photos to produce a cloned profile that will then be used to scam those friends."

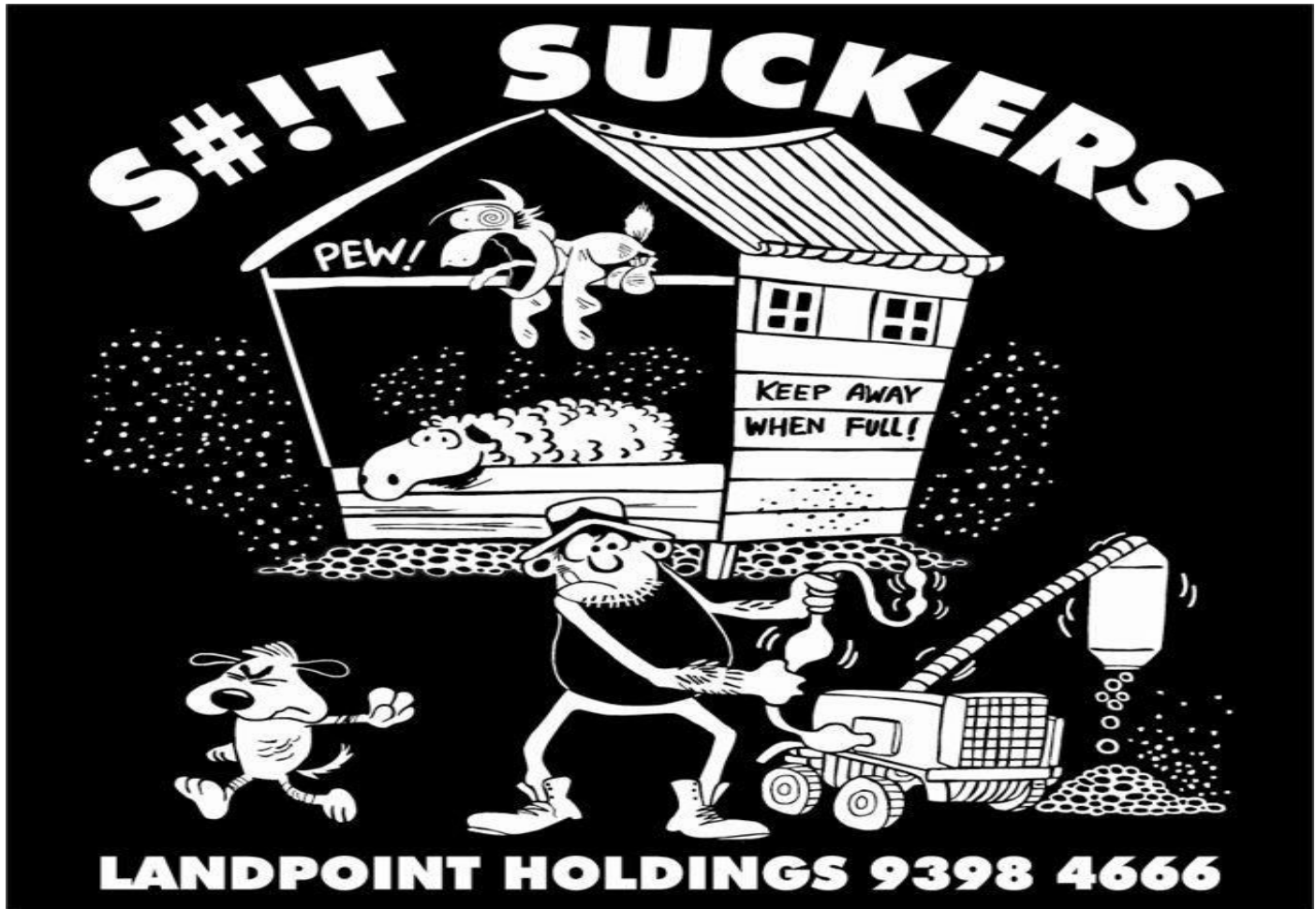
Tips

- If you get a message like this, pick up the phone and talk to your friend off Facebook before sending any money.
- Independently verify information provided (Google searches/confirm the grant provider and contact them directly).
- Did you recently receive another friend request from this person?
- Watch for differences in the language being used in the messages and compare it to how your friend would normally communicate.
- Ask yourself, why is your friend focused on you sending money?
- Why are you sending the funds in the method they are asking when you haven't received any verification in writing?
- Remember, Government or official agencies don't communicate about payments via social media.

Fiona is back!!.....but we've lost Travis. Hopefully the town will survive without the main man.

I've now completed my forensic course with the police, so I'm apparently a pro at collecting fingerprints, DNA, and half decent photographs. This will give a more thorough investigation, within a shorter timescale, and without having to rely on Albany forensic department to come to our area. This is still only for low level crimes, however hopefully it will assist the town and surrounding areas when it is required.

Since our last newsletter there has been very little going on in the way of reported crime. Well done!

That being said, this doesn't mean that we are a completely safe haven. It is still necessary to be vigilant in securing our homes and vehicles. We sometimes become a bit complacent being in a small town, and have the attitude that it won't happen here, but it does and will to some of us.



Make sure you lock your house up when you leave it, and also when you go to bed at night. When you park your car up, make sure that you leave no bags, and anything of value in sight. We are a thoroughfare from Esperance to Perth, and get a lot of travellers through town who may take the opportunity to take advantage of our

complacency. Simple answer is to lock up.

Lake Grace and Newdegate have several stop intersections dotted throughout, it has been noted that drivers are often just coming to a slow roll at a stop intersection without physically stopping the vehicle, i.e. wheels must stop rotating.



The following section of the Road Traffic Code covers stopping at stop signs.

Section 50 deal deals with:

Stopping and giving way at stop sign or stop line at an intersection without traffic-control signals.

A driver approaching or at an intersection with a "stop" sign or stop line shall stop as near as practicable to the stop line, where there is a stop sign only and no solid line then the driver must stop before entering the intersection.

The penalty for failing to do so is 3 demerit points and a \$300 fine for your efforts.

Parties/ Social gatherings a reminder.

Police have been called out several times over the past few weeks for noise complaints, we did touch on this subject a few weeks back explaining what powers Police have to enter a property and seize any equipment.

Just remember that if you are planning on having a get together that it may be a good idea just to let

your neighbours know in advance ,otherwise the “party” Police may get called out on overtime to come and ask you turn off the music.

Recipe Page

Chicken, miso & soba noodle soup

Ingredients

- 3 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- 6 skinless chicken thigh cutlets
- 150g mixed mushrooms
- 1 carrot, finely diced
- 1 celery stick, finely diced
- 1 brown onion, finely chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, smashed
- 1 tsp Chinese five spice
- 1/3 cup white miso paste
- 3l water (plus additions)
- 150g dried soba noodles
- 2cm piece of ginger, finely grates
- 2 tbsp soy sauce
- Thinly sliced red chilli (to garnish)
- Black sesame seeds (to garnish)
- Thinly sliced green shallots (to garnish)



Method

1. Cut some mushrooms in half, a few in to slices and leave the rest whole. Heat 1 tbsp of the oil in a large, wide heavy-based saucepan over a medium-high heat. Add vegetables, including mushrooms, and cook, stirring occasionally, for 8 minutes or until just tender and lightly browned. Transfer to a bowl and set aside.
2. To the same pan, add remaining oil. Once hot, add chicken and cook, turning once, for 5 minutes or until lightly browned on the outside. (chicken will not be cooked through at this time).
3. Return vegetables to pan, add herbs and spices, pour in liquid. Cover with lid and cook over a medium heat until simmering. Reduce the heat to low and simmer gently, still covered, for 1 1/2 hours or until chicken is fall apart tender.
4. Remove pan from heat, removed and transfer chicken to a chopping board and shred the meat off the bone. Discard bones.
5. Return pan to a low heat, add shredded chicken, stir in additional water if required. Bring to a simmer and cook for 10 minutes until noodles are tender. Ladle into bowls and top with garnish.
